REVIEW

How does Jesus provide us eternal glory?

Does the idea that suffering will only last for a little while encourage you?

How have you seen God use your struggles to restore, establish, strengthen and support you?

If God has dominion forever, how does that make you feel regarding eternity?

Do you feel like your hope is completely in God's plan for salvation? Do you have any doubts right now about salvation or eternity?

How would you define your living hope?

RESPOND

Take some time to think about all the ways God's grace has been there for you. Write down some of the ways you have seen His grace in your life.

Are there some places where you need God's grace today? Forgiveness of sin, help in a struggle, etc.? Spend some time in prayer asking for His grace in your struggles today.
