**REFLECT**

Do you still struggle with past regrets? How can you find peace in those things as you receive restoration from the Savior?

Do you believe that God has a purpose for your life?

How would you define that purpose?

Do you hunger for a deeper experience with God? Do you truly wish to receive everything that He wants for you to have in this life?

## **RESPOND**

Take some time this week to evaluate what God has given you.

Start with your faith and confidence.

Spend time in prayer asking for more and deeper faith.

Confess your doubts to God.

Spend time this week searching for answers to the doubts that you are facing.

Spend some time this week evaluating your restoration.
